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



National Corvette Museum Sinkhole

On February 12th a sinkhole collapsed in the skydome exhibit at the [National Corvette Museum](#) in Bowling Green Kentucky. Luckily no one was in or around the Museum at the time. The Fire Department has estimated the size of the hole was 40 feet across and 25-30 feet deep. Eight corvettes were swallowed in the sinkhole! Magnum got a call from Hayward Baker asking us to fabricate brackets specially for this project. We manufactured 50 kip working capacity micropile brackets with 5-1/2" sleeve. We also had to meet a very tight schedule to accommodate the urgency of the situation. Hayward Baker was the installer of our brackets.
